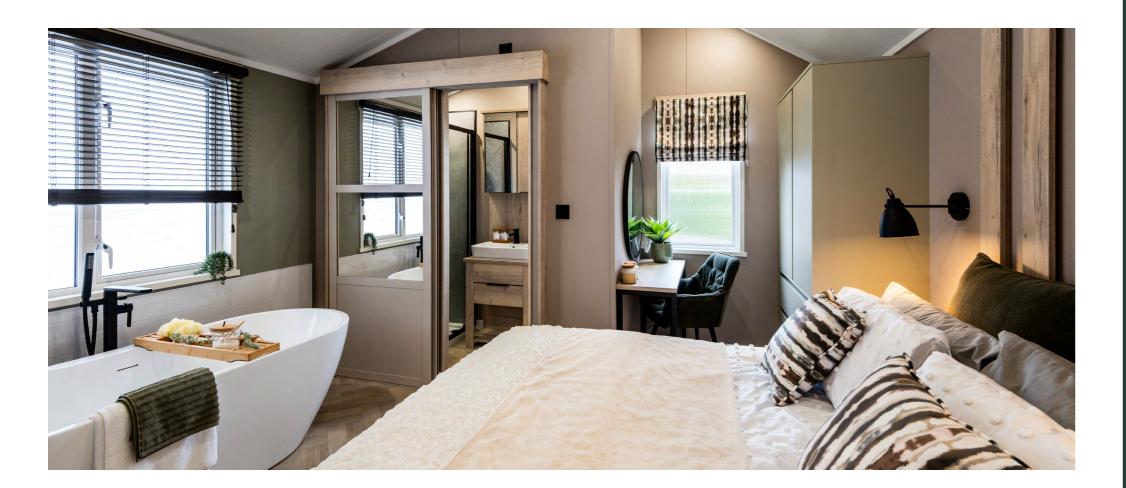

Spanning 64 acres, the park provides a secluded & well maintained countryside base, perfect for exploring one of the most idyllic areas in the country. We are dog-friendly, with a dedicated exercise area, and surrounded by scenic walking trails, including Beacon Fell, Longridge Fell, and the Lancashire Cheese Trail. There are countless opportunities for outdoor adventures right on our doorstep.

Our 52-week site licence allows owners to holiday year-round, whether basking in the summer sun or cosying up by the fire as the winter frost settles in. A 99-year licence ensures long-term security, and our on-site maintenance team are available to keep lodges in pristine condition. Every detail has been carefully considered to make your ownership experience seamless and stress-free.



How it Works

Stage 01 - Consultation

Consult one of our experienced and professional sales advisors.

Stage 02 - Identify your ideal lodge

Browse our range of exceptional holiday lodges and choose a design that will meet your ongoing needs.

Stage 03 - Get your technical specifications

Our choice of lodges have been created to make the most of all available space. We will provide all the technical specifications for your chosen lodge. In many cases, the cost of decking and skirting is included in the purchase price; full details will be provided.

Stage 04 - Reservation

Once you have chosen your lodge and plot within the park you will pay a £1000.00 reservation fee. This reservation fee is refundable for 14 days giving you time to check on funding and ensure you have all the information required. After 14 days we request a further 10% deposit (non-refundable) and the balance payment 2 weeks before completion.

Stage 05 - Final Touches

Upon final payment your lodge will be completed on your chosen plot and will then be gas and electric tested as well as plumbed and water tested. Any decking will then be fitted along with skirting in preparation of handover.

Stage 06 - Receive your lodge keys

Moving in day! We will prepare your site license agreement along with all relevant information regarding park ownership. You will need two forms of identification including photo identification to complete your ownership.

For those who need a quiet space to focus, we will also offer 14 office pod buildings, providing a peaceful environment for remote work or business needs.

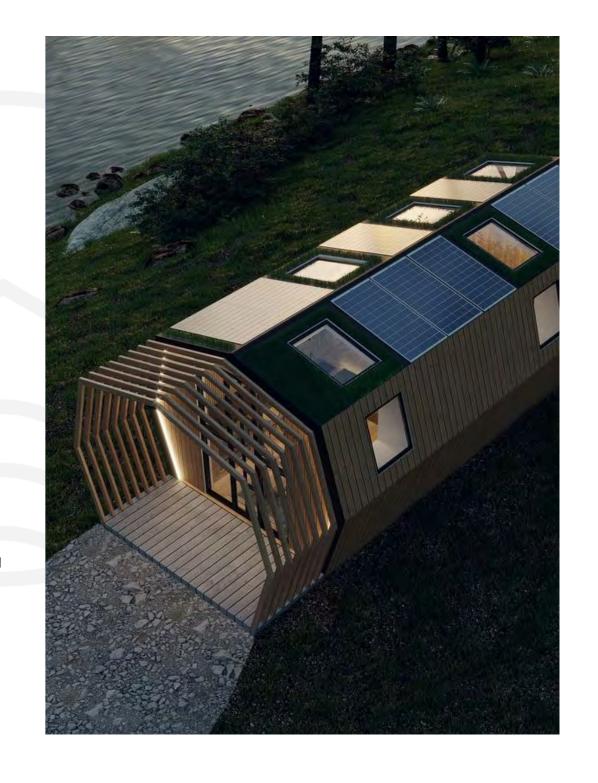
